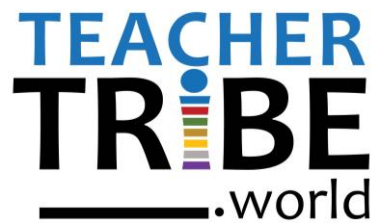

- World Teachers' Quiz ("Event/ Quiz") in the Digital/Online format is an individual participation event and will be completely held online/digitally.
- This quiz is open to only educational institutions to be represented by its teachers or faculty. There is **NO ENTRY FEE**.
- Any number of individuals from an institute can participate in the Quiz.
- There will be two levels of online selections conducted in this edition of the Event. The LEVEL 1 prelim will feature 20 questions, with a stipulated time limit for each question, with a combination of text based and visual based to select contestants for LEVEL 2.
- Based on pre-defined scoring parameters of the software, that include correct answers, time taken, unique answers, inbuilt tie breakers, etc., the top 32 scorers from Level 1 Prelim will qualify for Level 2 of this quiz. If there are any dropouts from the top 32 scorers, then the next top scorer could be invited for the level 2 of the quiz.
- **The entire quiz selection is being organised on a digital platform. The participants agree that the organisers would in no way be responsible for the internet connectivity that is required at all stages of the Quiz. It is the sole responsibility of the participant to equip themselves with robust internet facilities to take part in this quiz event.**
